An Outline of "Alan in Wonderland and the 3 Goats plus..."

The stage is set with 8 large roses hung on a backdrop and a swath of blue material over a pile of cases.

Lots of noise is heard behind the roses and a rabbit appears, using his ears. Then a shower of fish and cards (hearts) flutter down onto the stage. A lobster lands and hats and plates dash into the air. Everything falls down.

A stack of cases is revealed. Alan appears from behind cases in a state of panic.

The cases are repeatedly reorganised and finally opened, a bit late.

Alan finds the book of the story 'Alan in Wonderland and the 3 Goats plus...'

2nd page 'Once upon a time, long ago, far away.

 This is added to. 'Twice upon a time and thrice upon a time.'

3rd page ' everything stops for tea.'

We stop for a tea find a small door that we look through and see a picnic.

Alan sets the picnic and gets the audience to mime drinking tea.

Then children that know something starting with a 't' are invited to have tea. Up to nine are chosen. They are invited to wear mad hats.

Learn to be teapots. Sing and mime.

'I'm a little teapot short and stout, here's my handle here's my spout

Pick me up and pour me out.'

After pouring out, we pick the pottiest teapot to come back and help us Patrol for goats.

We build a bridge for the Goats to cross so we can take a trip from here to there and go to the greener side. Lots of trip and trapping.

Out potty person is invited back up and dressed as a troll.

The troll asks for a toll, and then tries to eat the goats.

2 goats get across and the 3rd goat tries to barge its way over.

The 3rd goat finds the troll is just a child and says they'll get on really well on the greener side.

All escape the bridge and come over to the greener side for tea and cake.
